

The rate quoted by the tenderer for supply of Aluminium Phosphide Tablets, Fumigant per kg will be holds good irrespective of the packing. The Aluminium Phosphide Tablets, Fumigant should conforming to IS: 6438-1980 with up to date amendments & shall be supply to the Regional Managers Offices located at Mysore, Bangalore, Shimoga, Davanagere, Hubli, Gulbarga and Raichur located at Karnataka state:

TERMSCONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

1. SPECIFICATIONS

Description	: Aluminium Phosphide tablets with ISI Mark
Quantity	: The requirement upto 25000Kgs
Standard	: a) Aluminium Phosphide tablets conforming to IS:6438-1980 with upto date amendments. The weight tolerance limit for acceptance shall be as per BIS Specification i.e. \pm (plus or Minus) 5% variation in the standard weights. b) Each tablet of 3 gms. Shall release 1 gm of gaseous phosphine, non-explosive and stable on exposure to atmosphere. It shall also emanate Ammonia gas simultaneously. c) The product shall also be IS marked and of recent manufacture not more than one month old at the time of offering for pre-purchase inspection.
Guarantee	The product shall be guaranteed against disintegration and deterioration for a period of 2 years from the date of manufacture.
Purpose	Eradicate (kill) different types and stages of living insects at stored grain through fumigation by used 2-3 tablets of Aluminium Phosphide per tonne.
Packing	Packing shall be as per IS: 9503-1988 with up-to-date amendments. The tablets shall be packed in leak proof, air tight, seamless, extruded Aluminium bottle/flask containing 1 kg of chemical consisting of not less than 334 tablets. Proportionate quantitative cut for the number of tablets found short shall be made based on the average weight of the tablet.
Quantity	: The requirement upto 25000 kgs.
Marking	: The each container & each cases shall bear legibly and indelibly the

The Bidder should submit the following documents for acceptance of technical bid through online e-procurement portal.

- a) The Tenderer should submit copy of proof for EMD amount remitted through e-procurement portal.
- b) The copy of the valid licence and registration certificate issued by the competent authority.
- c) The copy of Supply order issued by the central/state government, government undertakings/Boards/corporations from 2014-15 and should submit the copies for 25% of this tender quantity supplied in any one of the year.
- d) Undertaking letter by the tenderer for any deterioration in 2 years.
- e) The copy of the ISI Registration certificate.
- f) The Tenderer should furnish copies of Certificates issued by Chartered Accountant for the year 2014-15, 2015-16 & 2016-17. The Annual turnover should be minimum of Rs. 1.25 Crores for any of the year from 2014-15
- g) Income tax return copies filed for the year 2014-15, 2015-16 & 2016-17
- i) The copy of Self declaration for not involving in ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by any State Government / Government of India /Union Territory.
- j) The copy of the PAN card.
- k) The copy of cancelled Bank cheque leaf for Bank IFSC code, Account No.


The tenderer should submit the above documents through online e-procurement portal failure to which the technical bid of the tender will be rejected.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The tender for supply of Aluminium Phosphide have been invited as per Karnataka Transparency in public procurement Act 1999 and rules 2000. Accordingly two cover bid system consisting of Technical bid and Financial bid shall be followed.
2. The Financial bid of the tenderer shall be opened only of the tenderer who qualifies in the Technical bid.
3. The tenderer should furnish Earnest Money Deposit(E.M.D) through online. The E.M.D shall be liable to be forfeited if the tenderer does not fulfill tender conditions.The EMD amount of successful & unsuccessful tenderer will be refunded after finalization of tender. The EMD does not carry any interest.
4. The Successful tenderer shall furnish security deposit @5.5% of the total value of the ordered quantity of Aluminium Phosphide by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Managing Director. KSWC", Bangalore, within 7 days from the date of acceptance of the rates. The security deposit will be refunded only after one-year from the date of supplied OR supplied quantity exhausted. The security deposit does not carry any interest. The Earned Money Deposit of the successful tenderer shall not be adjusted towards the security deposit and it will not carry any interest .
5. The tenderer should quote rate per Kg in financial bid. Which should be inclusive of Central and State sales tax, excise duty, VAT, octroi charges and all other taxes levied or may be levied in future without submission of form "C" and "D" or any other similar form prescribed under any relevant Act in force and delivery on F.O.R basis to the Regional Manager Offices/Warehouses. The transportation charges, loading & other charges should be borne by the supplier.
6. The rate will not be increased once the rate accepted by the corporation. Any request to increase the rates will not be considered during the one year period or extended period of two months.
7. The tenderer should quote rate Per Kg in financial bid at e-procurement portal. The rate quoted shall be valid for a period of One year or extended period of two months from the date of acceptance of the tender rates.
8. The tenderer who has signed the tender should be present or may depute his / their authorized representative to be present at the time of opening of tender if they so desire, along with the authority letter duly attested.
9. Each tenderer should mention his postal address with pin code, phone number, fax number, e-mail etc. The KSWC will not be responsible for any non-receipt of information furnished by the tenderer with incorrect postal information.
10. The Aluminium Phosphide should be dispatched & covered under transit insurance for dispatch to the Regional Manager Offices located at Mysore, Bangalore, Hubli, Davanagere, Shimoga, Gulbarga and Raichur and warehouses located at Karnataka state.
11. The material should be delivered on F.O.R. basis. In case of any damages or shortages found at the destination, will have to be replaced by the tenderer at free of cost.
12. The tenderer should be offered for pre- inspection at a time, within 20 days from the date of supply order. The material shall be of recent manufacture which should not be more than one month old from the date offered for pre-inspection. The inspection officer of the

Corporation would inspect the stores at your factory and draw the random sample at his discretion in respect of supplies to be made and get it tested by any recognized laboratory as decided by the Corporation. The laboratory test charges should be borne by the successful tenderer. Delivery of the Aluminium Phosphide to the destination shall be done only after confirmation letter received from the Corporation that the stores confirms to I.S. Specification and dispatches can be made within Seven days from the date of receipt of dispatch order. If the successful tenderer fails to offer for pre-inspection and to deliver the Aluminium Phosphide with in the stipulated time, penalty will be imposed as decided by Managing Director, KSWC.

13. The payment for supply of Aluminium Phosphide shall be made only after receipt of proof of dispatched documents and receipt of stock certificates from the Regional Managers / Warehouse Managers, that Aluminium Phosphide are received in good conditions.
 14. The product shall be guaranteed against any deterioration for a period of two years from the date of manufacture.
 15. The successful tenderer should execute an agreement on Stamp paper of value Rupees One hundred for supply of Aluminium Phosphide as per tender condition within 7 days from the date of intimation of accepted rate. There should be no escalation clause in the tender.
 16. The Managing Director, KSWC reserves the right to accept or reject the tenders or to increase or decrease the quantity of the Aluminium Phosphide without assigning any reasons.
 17. The rate shall remain valid for a period of one year or extended period of two months from the date of issue of acceptance of the tender or work order, so desired by the Corporation. The tenderer shall be bound to make supplies as per tender in such quantities as KSWC may place an order from time to time throughout the period of one year or extended period for two months.
 18. The opening of Technical Bid or Financial Bid will be opened on next working day, if any general holiday declared on schedule date .
 19. In the event of any breach of terms, conditions of the tender, the Managing Director, KSWC have right to terminate the tender & cancelled the work order issued. The E.M.D. amount, security deposit will be forfeited or any appropriate action deemed fit by the Managing Director towards recovery of amount due towards damages or expenses that will be incurred by the Corporation for the default of the supplier under the tender as their in stated above. Further the successful tenders shall be black listed and intimated to the concerned.
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20. The successful tenderer fails to do or comply with any terms and conditions of the tender, the Managing Director, KSWC shall have all the right to cancel the tender and call for fresh tender. In such case E.M.D and security deposit furnished by the tenderer shall be forfeited without a prejudice to the other right legally available and call for fresh tender at his risk and cost and the tenderer liable to make good the difference or loss to the Corporation.
